Reading- Matthew 14: 30-31 NKJV

30- But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!"

31- And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

Peter steps out of the boat and walks on the water next to Jesus. But after some time, the storm grows stronger and, overwhelmed by a situation over which he has no control, Peter begins to sink. Immediately, Jesus saves Peter. But then asks one question "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

When storms in life happen, it's oh so easy to have the same reactions as Peter. We can become so focused on the problems around us that we can lose sight of our Saviour standing right by us. But even when all hope seems lost, He is near. His constant presence is our confident assurance that through all of life's storms, God is, and always will be, in control.

Whatever we're going through at this present time, be encouraged: The Great Architect is our anchor, He is able to do the impossible, and he will not let us drown. So, let us hold on to our hope by keeping our eyes firmly fixed on Him.
